

Student computer requirements at Cairns school of distance education

Students can purchase either a desktop or laptop computer. But preferably students have a laptop that meets the below hardware and software specification.

Students are encouraged to purchase a Windows based laptop but an Apple Mac is also supported.

Computer specification requirements (Windows) Desktop, All-in-One, Laptop

- ☑ Windows 10 64bit Operating system as a Min however you can purchase Windows 11. Note there is limited support provided on how to use the device.
- ☑ Intel Core i5 Core processor or AMD Ryzen equivalent (minimum requirement 1.5 Mhz Intel 4000 or GeForce 9000 graphics card 250GB Solid state hard drive (SSD)
- 8GB RAM
- ☑ DVD or USB A and C connection. External DVD?
- ☑ Inkable touch screen and pen (Desirable)
- ☑ Integrated webcam on all laptops. Typically used for Microsoft Teams.
- ☑ External webcam for desktop devices. (eg. Logitech C505 Webcam) 1080DPI resolution for Video.
 - **Note!** * External webcam allows students to position the camera angle without disrupting the screen.
- ☑ USB Headset (headphones and microphone). The price can range from \$40 to \$150 (eg. Logitech H390 or H540)
 - **Note!** * Surround Sound Gaming Headsets are not compatible and cannot be guaranteed to work*
 - **Optional!** Noise cancelling feature provides clear communication.
- ☑ Wireless Bluetooth headsets can also be used with laptops.

Accessories

To get the most out of your new laptop or tablet computer/s, you may wish to consider accessories that will improve the usability or overcome their form factor limitations.

External/Additional Monitor

- 24" to 34" screen size is ideal (one large ultrawide monitor may replace two smaller monitors and is great for spreadsheets)
- If you're implementing a dual monitor setup, try to get a matching pair (same brand and resolution) for less eye strain

Ensure that the resolution is at least 1920 x 1080

Other Considerations for student devices

- Devices need to be assessed for robustness and transportability e.g. shock proof, handle, screen structure
- Whether you intend to use Charging stations i.e. ability to securely store in suitable in accessible/lockable stations
- Support processes including access to tech, teacher training and software partnerships
- Blended learning requirements
- Increasing use of Augmented Reality (AR) / Virtual Reality (VR) and game based learning in classrooms
- Student engagement with devices e.g. colour choices, aesthetic
- Consider the full details when purchasing Accidental Damage Protection (ADP) some have a low purchase price but a high excess (cost to initiate claim), while others might limit the number of claims per period (i.e. 1 claim per year)
