

School Uniform Dress Standard

Our school uniform dress standard has been designed to outline our agreed clothing and personal presentation standard for our students when attending or representing our school, travelling to or from school, or engaging in school activities out of school hours. Our school uniform has been devised by the Cairns SDE P & C Association.

Students are expected to wear the school uniform at all school events and to take pride in its appearance. For School Leaders and students representing our school in public appearances in the community, school uniform is required. Public functions include Presentation Evening, ANZAC Day ceremonies, study days, mini schools and other nominated school events. The school uniform colours are GREY and MAROON.

School Uniform: for all students

Top: Cairns SDE unisex polo-shirt with school logo.

Bottom: Student's choice of shorts/trousers or skirt:

- Appropriate to activity
- Maroon, grey or dark colours
- Comfortable

Note: Year 12 students are permitted to wear the current year's Senior shirt.

Footwear: Closed-in shoes are required for all school activities.

Hats: Students must wear a Cairns SDE sun safe hat for any outside activity in accordance with the Cairns SDE Sun Safety Policy. **Definitely no caps, sun visors, etc.**

Sunglasses: May be worn during outdoor activities.

Jewellery: Please wear the absolute minimum of jewellery for formal and public functions representing the school. This may include a single stud or small earring in each ear, a simple necklace or chain.

Sunscreen & Insect Repellent: Wear broad spectrum 30+ sunscreen and insect or mosquito repellent for any field or outdoor activities.

Water Activities: Wear swim shirts for any water based activities for additional sun protection.

Workplace, Health & Safety: Comply with Workplace, Health & Safety regulations and dress appropriately for the activities and location of the event. If in doubt, please ask Cairns SDE staff for assistance.
