- Students wishing to study a language in Years 11 & 12 must have achieved a satisfactory standard at Year 10 Level. ** Year 10 Languages are not beginner courses.
- New subjects for 2025: Short Course Careers Education (1 year 1 QCE), Certificate III Business (2 years 8 QCE)
