



Suggested computer requirements

Hardware

To study remotely, access to a computer with a DVD drive is essential. Most study material is available online, but on rare occasions discs are sent out without an alternative online option.

To attend lessons you will require an internet connection with a minimum speed of 256Kbps. This connection will also be used for Internet research and email, so a plan with at least 10GB of data allowance per month is advised.

It is the responsibility of the family to provide computer equipment including a USB headset with microphone for online lessons which prevents audio feedback to others in the class.

If you're planning to purchase a new laptop the preferred option would be a Windows 10 device with at least 4GB of RAM. Laptops with Intel Core i3 chips are cheaper but buying one with either an i5 or i7 will prolong the life of your machine. Mac computers can be used but may have difficulties reading the C2C and other material supplied on DVD.

Software
