At Cairns SDE, students in year 10 will study either 6 or 7 subjects from the Australian Curriculum. Subjects studied will include:

- English, Math and Science across the whole year
- Health & Physical Education and History for one semester each
- Up to two specialisations across the whole year

General Information:

- Details about subjects including the specialisation choices are outlined in subject overviews available on our website.
- Students can undertake a Certificate II or higher either externally or with the school, instead of specialisation subjects in Year 10.
- The order in which subjects studied for only one semester are determined by student form class.

SPECIALIST SUBJECT SELECTION:

Note:

- Students must select a minimum of one specialist subject, from either line A or B
- Students may select a maximum of two specialist subjects. One from line A and one from line B
- Students may nominate a Certificate course in place of a specialist subject -

Conditions:

- **All language subjects** have a prerequisite requirement, i.e. *The language must have been studied in the previous year and the student must have achieved a passing grade (C or better). Evidence is required, e.g. Report Card.* ** Year 10 Languages are not beginner courses.
- Short Course Careers Education is a Semester 1 only subject (1 QCE), students will need to select a second subject for Semester 2.
