The interim feedback is that we need to focus on:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ data literacy and refining our data plan</li> <li>▪ defining our signature pedagogy so it is more suited to SDE</li> <li>▪ whole of school curriculum plan and adapting the curriculum</li> <li>▪ instructional leadership</li> </ul> </li> <li>○ Staff will be consulted over the next 2 weeks of school</li> <li>○ The draft Quadrennial School Review will be presented at the Biannual forum</li> </ul>

Same day notification policy (Andrew )		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Context:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Same Day Student Absence Notification policy has been released. The policy is as follows:                   <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>“The safety and wellbeing of students are the highest priorities for the department. Parents need to know if their child hasn't turned up for school, and schools need to know when and why a child is absent ... From the beginning of 2017, state schools will be required to notify parents on the same day that any student is absent from school without explanation.”</i></li> <li>▪ In the FAQ's it goes on to specifically mention SDE: Students enrolled in a School of Distance Education (SDE) do not physically attend school but participate online from home. Do same day student absence notifications still apply? Yes. <i>‘Attendance’ for a student enrolled in a SDE requires them to participate in scheduled lessons, respond to and submit tasks online and sometimes attend in person (e.g. for field events). If this does not occur for a student when it is expected and there is no explanation provided by the parent/carer, the SDE should notify the parent/carer as soon as practicable on the day of the student’s ‘absence’.</i></li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Jan 2017	A. 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			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Funds were also distributed to establish PEDALS Program.</li> <li>○ Smart Schools Subsidy Scheme proposal to build a new dormitory was submitted to P&amp;C by a sub-committee and was rejected.</li> <li>○ P&amp;C resolved to pursue the refurbishment G Block.
